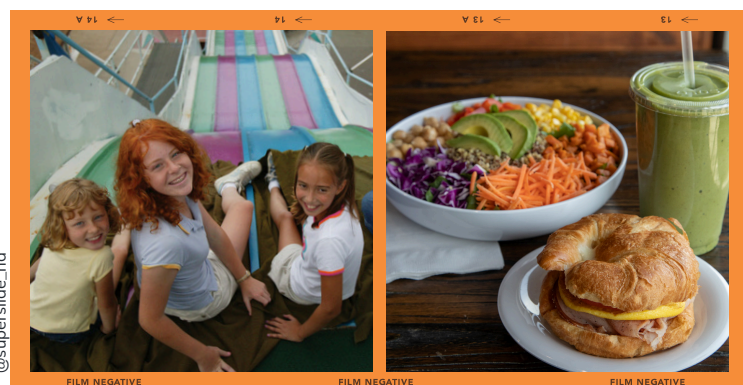
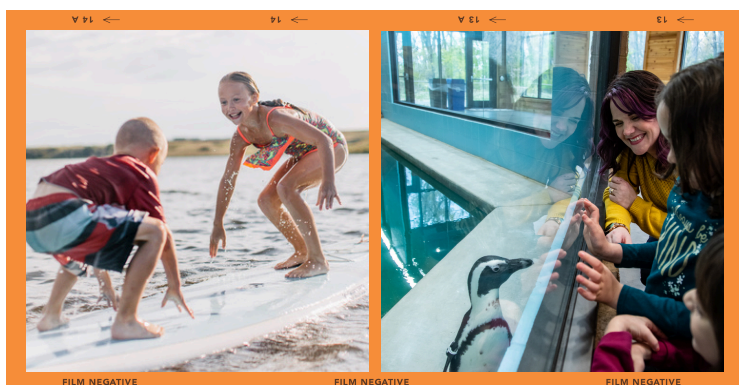
### ***Where can we get the best coffee or tea drink?***

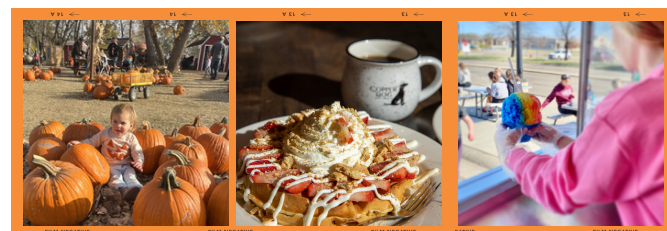
